Form of manuscript

Papers must be in English and presented in the following order:

- Title of paper
- Initials and surname of each author; name of author to whom correspondence should be addressed, his e-mail address
- Affiliation(s) of each author
- Abstract (one paragraph)
- Key words (up to 6)
- Text of paper
- Acknowledgements
- References
- Tables (arabic numerals) and titles, each table on a separate sheet
- Figure legends

To facilitate communication between authors, editors and publisher, the telephone and FAX numbers and/or E-mail address of the corresponding author should be provided on the title page of each manuscript.

Manuscripts must be accompanied by the "Copyright Transfer Statement" (the form is regularly published in this journal).

Manuscripts should be typed in double-line spacing throughout on one side of the paper only and with at least 2.5 cm (1 inch) margins. (Three manuscript pages equal approximately one printed page.)

Papers that do not conform to journal norms may be returned to the authors for revision before being considered for publication. Corrections in the proof must be restricted to typesetting errors, as the authors will be charged for making changes at the proof stage. The text should be arranged as follows:

Introduction. The nature, history, and purpose of the work should be stated briefly and the most relevant literature cited.

Methods. Details of the clinical and technical procedures should be included.

Results. The results are to be presented clearly, concisely, and without comment.

Discussion. The results are explained and related to those of other authors; their significance for clinical practice should be specified.

References. The references cited in the text should be listed at the end of the paper and numbered in the order they are cited in the text; in the text they are referred to by numerals in square brackets. Journal titles should be abbreviated according to the *List of Journals Indexed in Index Medicus*. Abstracts, editorials, and letters to the editor should be noted as such.

Illustrations. Figures should be numbered consecutively with arabic numerals and the legends should be typed on a separate sheet. Graphs and diagrams must be black-and-white drawings suitable for reproduction. Computer drawings are acceptable provided they are of comparable quality to line drawings. Computer-drawn curves and lines must be smooth. Photographs should be sharp and glossy and submitted in the size to be printed (column width: 8.6 cm; printing area width: 17.6 cm; length of page 22.4 cm). For color illustrations

the authors will be expected to make a contribution € 485 per article towards the extra costs. The author must guarantee that the permission of the patient or his/her legal representative has been obtained for the use of photographs of patients who can be recognized.

Review articles, invited or submitted, should be comprehensive but restricted to the publications necessary to review the subject adequately.

Original papers should report on new research.

Technical notes should describe unusual technical aspects.

Case reports and **Case notes** will not be published in the journal.

Footnotes should be placed at the foot of the page to which they apply and numbered consecutively throughout the article.

Manuscripts in electronic form. Submission of electronic data is encouraged. Springer offers a user-friendly Word document template for writing your manuscript. Please consult the Technical instructions for manuscripts and illustrations in electronic form published regularly in this journal. Please do not transmit any data to the publisher until your manuscript has been reviewed and accepted for publication.
