

INFORMATION TO AUTHORS

Manuscripts

Hämostaseologie publishes original papers and review articles in German or English. The manuscript should be organized according to the type of the assigned category. It is essential to divide the manuscript in e.g. Summary, Introduction, Material and Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusion, and Literature. The most important sections should be stressed by subheadings.

Acceptance of Manuscripts

Manuscripts are submitted with the understanding that they are **original contributions** and do not contain data that have been published elsewhere. Manuscripts are reviewed by the scientific editors, who will decide on the acceptance. It is taken for granted that the publication has been approved by all participating authors. Moreover, in the case of the author being subject to instructions of the institute director, his consent must be obtained. Address of Submissions see Impressum

Size of the manuscript

- Original articles: up to 36,000 characters incl. space bars (10–20 DIN-A4-pages)
- Review articles: up to 45,000 characters incl. space bars (20–25 DIN-A4-pages)
- 1½ spaced, type size 12 pt, Style: Times New Roman

Title page

A short and concise German and English title of the paper, the authors' names, the names of the institutions in which the work was done, and the name and title of the head of the institution.

Keywords and Summary

A **German and an English** summary (up to 1,200 characters incl. space bars) as well as 3–4 keywords in German and English.

Figures and Tables

- Tables and figures are scanned and used directly for printing. After scanning no further corrections can be made.
- Figures can be sent as: slides, glossy photographs, radiographs, video printouts, photoprints and high quality b/w printouts.
- Figures can also be sent as digital documents. Graphics must be saved in .tif or .eps format with a minimum resolution of 800 dpi (line drawings) or 300 dpi (photographs). Jpg format is only possible when scanned and saved in high quality (300 and 800 dpi, resp.).
- Submit only clear, glossy, reproducible figures and tables.
- Symbols, lettering, and numbering large enough to remain legible after the figure has been reduced.
- Figures and tables must have a minimum width of 57 mm.
- One font-size, no frames.
- On the back of each figure note the figure number, name of the author, and designation of the top.
- The cost of redrawing will be borne by the author.

- For color illustrations a contribution of € 250.– will be charged to the author.
- **Legends:** at the end of the manuscript.
- **Tables:** at the end of the manuscript, and printed on separate pages.

Figures and tables already published must be accompanied by written permission from both author and Publisher to reproduce the figure (also author's own illustrations or tables). The correct source is given in the legend.

References

- Arranged alphabetically (first author) and numbered consecutively, max. 40 references, review articles up to 100.
- According to Index Medicus and Vancouver Style.

Name and address of the corresponding author with phone and fax number at the end of the reference list.

Submit your manuscript with a hard copy. Files and hard copy must be identical.

Storing the manuscript on disc

Text, tables and figures must be saved separately. Please save figures in .eps or .tif format (see above) and do not import into Word.

- 3.5-inch-disc or CD-ROM.
- DOS format
- Please indicate on the disc or CD-ROM the word processing software and version.

Nomenclature and Abbreviations

According to internationally approved rules. Trade names of propriety brands may be stated additionally to the generic name, incl. the name of the producer.

The author is responsible **for the content of the text**. Any information on dosage and method of application is supplied without liability of the Publisher and the Editor-in-Chief. The user takes full responsibility for doses and applications.

Authors should avoid the use of names of patients. Patients should not be recognizable from photographs unless their written permission has first been obtained.

Conflict of interest

Authors should acknowledge any financial interests in companies that market material that are, or have been, the subject of research reported in the manuscript. Such information will be held in confidence while the paper is under review and will not influence the editorial decision, but

if the article is accepted for publication, there will be a short note for our readers.

Proofreading

Proofreading within the period prescribed; corrections arriving later cannot be considered. Authors may be charged for extensive alterations in the galley proofs, if the cost of the author's alterations exceed 10% of the cost of composition.

Reprints

Reprints can be ordered by the authors in advance. An order form showing the cost of reprints is enclosed with the page proofs. Other people interested in obtaining reprints are asked to contact the publisher's department for reprints.

Checklist:

- **Size of the manuscript:** In total max. 36,000 characters (original articles) or 45,000 characters (review articles) incl. space bars, Summary up to 1,200 characters incl. space bars, 3–4 keywords
- **Structure:** Title (German and English), authors, facilities, running head, Keywords/Summary (German and English), Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion, References, Address of the author, Legends, Figures and Tables
- **Hard copy:** DIN-A4, type size 12 pt
- **Disc:** DOS format
- **Figures:** high quality drafts, ready for reproduction. Save graphics in .tif format with a minimum resolution of 800 dpi. Photographics in .eps format with a minimum resolution of 300 dpi.
- **References:** Vancouver style, max. 40 (original articles) or 100 (review articles) citations
